Eligibility Criteria

- Students must have a minimum GPA of 3.0
- Students must complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

Additional Information

- Preference will be given to those who demonstrate financial need.
- Award may not exceed tuition and matriculation fees.
- Recipients of the scholarship will meet at least once annually with the Senior Center membership to discuss their academic progress.
